

RECIPROCAL LICENSE APPLICATION

Appraisers who hold a valid credential from another state may apply for reciprocity in California provided that the credentialing requirements of the applicant's credentialing state meet or exceed those of BRE. The following documents must be **submitted for a reciprocity application:**

- A. Application for reciprocal license ([REA 3025](#)) form.
- B. Consent to Service of Process ([REA 3006](#)) form.
- C. Evidence of a valid license from another state.
 - Proof of completing Minimum four (4) hours course on federal and California appraisal related statutory and regulatory law and one (01) hour course on cultural competency must be completed.
 - Valuation Bias and Fair Housing Laws and Regulations (8 Hours) course must be completed.
- D. Request for Live Scan service ([BCIA 8016](#)) form or two FD-258 cards completed fingerprint cards if they reside outside California.
